We had a great turnout at our first annual Los Compadres Neighborhood Organization Annual Meeting last month and the new Board is working on blade signs installation, programs and events for 2013.

The next Board of Advisors Meeting is on May 7, 2013, from 6-8 p.m., at the [Demuth Park Community Center](#). We have 1 additional Board spot available and alternate positions. Anyone interested in helping us grow the LCNO, should attend this meeting. All meetings of the LCNO Board of Advisors are open to the public. Residents of the Los Compadres area are encouraged to attend and participate.

Los Compadres Blade Signs Update

The City has now approved our Blade sign design and we are in the process of getting quotes for manufacturing. Once ordered, the printing takes approximately 3-4 weeks and installation by the City can take 6-8 weeks. So be on the lookout for the signs to go up over the summer...

As was mentioned at the meeting, while the City pays for installation of the signs, the LCNO must raise the funds to purchase the signs. So far we have commitments and donations to fund approximately 25 signs. A really great start! With about 40 "sign-able" intersections, we will continue requesting additional donations until we place our first order. The cost to sponsor a sign will be approximately \$160-180.
