OPEN HOUSE ON
PROPOSED BRIDGES

An open house will be held on Wednesday, June 26, at 6 P.M. in the Large Conference Room at City Hall regarding two proposed bridge projects. One would be a new bridge on Vista Chino Drive to replace the existing lowwater crossing at the Whitewater River and the other would be widening the existing Ramon Road Bridge from four to 6 through lanes. SoCalGas' New Innovative Advanced Meter

Over the next few months, Southern California Gas Company is upgrading its system in Palm Springs and throughout the Coachella Valley by installing the new Advanced Meter on all residential and business natural gas meters. The Advanced Meter will automatically read and



transmit your gas usage to the SoCalGas customer service and billing department. The device will be installed on your existing analog meter and is battery operated turning on for just a fraction of a second a each day. The batteries are good for 20 years. Importantly, the meters do not communicate with any other meters, or appliances in your home. Also, the meters cannot turn on or turn off your gas service. SoCalGas provide customers a 30 day notice of Advanced Meters installation which does not interrupt gas service nor does the customer need to be home. City of Palm Springs Code Enforcement



The new Palm Springs Director of Code Enforcement, Jim Zicaro, addressed the PSNIC Code Enforcement and Public Works Committee on May 29th, 2013. His department is now fully staffed with 3 code enforcement officers who respond to resident complaints,

which may be made in person at City Hall, by phone or online. They also conduct proactive patrols looking for violations. The largest number of complaints received by the Code Enforcement Office relate to property maintenance followed by zoning related questions. As of January 2013, they are now logging the neighborhood with each complaint, which will make it easier for NOs to track neighborhood issues more easily.
